

SAINT OF THE WEEK - October 24th

St. Anthony Mary Claret was born in the town of Sallent in the Provence of Barcelona, Spain on December 23, 1807. He was the fifth of eleven children to Juan and Josefa Claret. He considered becoming a Carthusian monk but entered the diocesan seminary at Vic in 1829. He was ordained in 1835, where, after four more years of studying theology, he aspired to become a missionary. He traveled to Rome and entered the Jesuit noviciate to fulfill this desire, but fell ill to the point where he could not continue. He returned to pastoral ministry in the Viladrau and Girona, regions of Spain, where he concentrated his efforts toward the poor. His superiors elevated him to domestic Apostolic Missionary in the Catalonian regions. He was an elegant preacher and spent many hours in the confessional, and was said to have possessed the gift of discernment of consciences. In 1848, his life was threatened by anti-clerical enemies and he was set to the Canary Islands for his safety. Upon his return to Spain, he established the Congregation of the Missionary Sons of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, commonly known as the Claretians. He was appointed Archbishop of Santiago, Cuba by Pope Pius IX. In Santiago, he revitalized the seminary and strengthened clerical discipline. One of his great achievements was developing an educational system for poor and disadvantaged youths in the vocational trades. He ingeniously started credit unions that aided the poor. He defended the oppressed and fought racism vigorously. He claimed to have experienced a Eucharistic miracle wherein he heard Jesus speaking of three conditions that would greatly affect mankind: 1) wars, 2) powerful demons of pleasure, love of money, false reasoning and a will separated from that of God, and 3) Communism that would suppress Christians. In 1869, Claret traveled to Rome for the First Vatican Council. While there, he fell ill and retired to the to the Cistercian Abbey at Fontfroide in southern France, where he died on October 24, 1870. He was canonized on May 7, 1950 for his great works by Patron of textile merchants and Pope Pius XII. weavers, savings (taught the poor the value of savings), the founder of the Claretian Religious Order.
