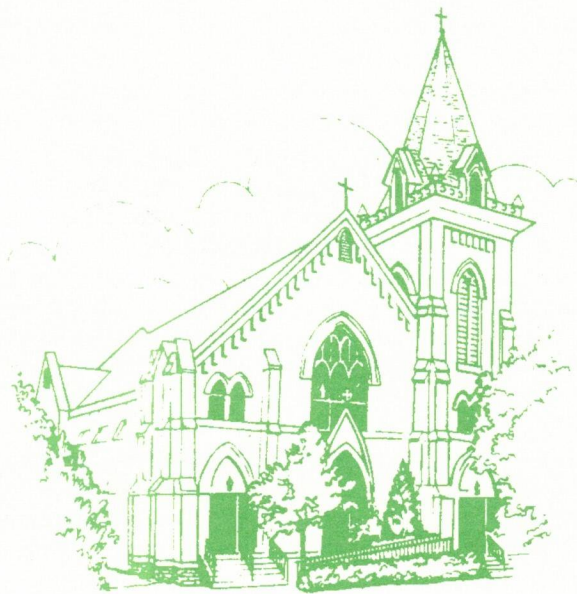

**FEAST OF THE WEEK – November 9th**

**The Feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran** is universally celebrated throughout the Roman Catholic Church as the oldest Christian church in the West. The Basilica was originally named the Archbasilica of the Most Holy Savior that was dedicated by Pope Sylvester I in the year 324 AD. At some point in its history, it colloquially became known as St. John Lateran for two reasons: 1) the monks of monasteries of St. John the Baptist and St John the Divine served it, and 2) the property on which the Basilica was built was donated by the Laterini family. St. John Lateran is the oldest and highest-ranking of the four major basilicas in Rome. Surprising to many, St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome is not where the chair (cathedra) of Rome exists. St. John Lateran is the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome and where the reigning Holy Father, the pope, is heralded as the pastor and bishop. Over the door, the Latin inscription reads, “Mother and head of all the churches of the city and the world.” On this solemnity, the central theme of the Word of God recalls an essential truth: the temple of stones is a symbol of the living Church, the Christian community, which in their letters, the Apostles Peter and Paul already understood as a “spiritual edifice,” built by God with “living stones,” namely, Christians themselves, upon the one foundation of Jesus Christ, who is called the “cornerstone.” All the popes after the 4<sup>th</sup> century, up until 1309, resided in Rome until the Avignon (France) controversy that split the Church that year into two competing papal reigns (pope vs anti-pope). When the papacy finally returned to Rome in 1377, the Basilica had declined so precipitously that a new residence was built for future popes next to St. Peter’s on Vatican Hill.
