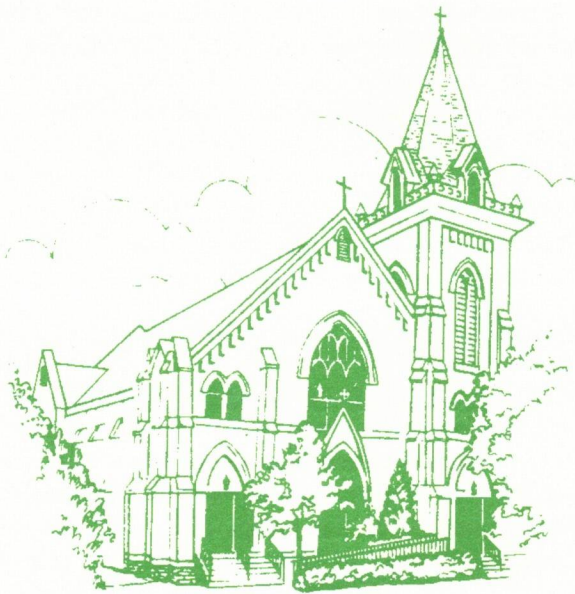

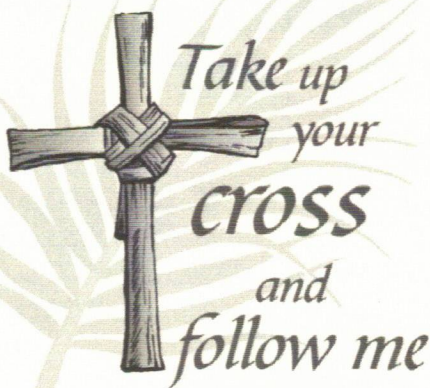
## Parish Membership

**FEAST OF THE WEEK – September 8th**

**The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary** – is the feast that the Roman Catholic Church, Eastern Orthodox Church, Anglican and Lutheran Christians commemorate as the birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus. The canon of scriptures does not record the birth of Mary. The document *"Protoevangelium of James"* that appeared in written form in the early years of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Century AD describes Mary's father, Joachim, as a wealthy man and her mother, Anne, as being deeply grieved by her previous childlessness. Only Jesus, Mary and John the Baptist have both their births and deaths commemorated on the Church calendar, mainly for their singular and important mission in salvation history. This feast became known as Marymas after the 6<sup>th</sup> Century AD when the date of September 8<sup>th</sup> was chosen for the feast. Logically, this date is nine months following her Immaculate Conception celebrated on December 8<sup>th</sup>. Through this Immaculate Conception where Mary was conceived and born without original sin, the only fully human being having been bestowed this honor. **Patronage of many countries, cities, churches and religious orders.**
