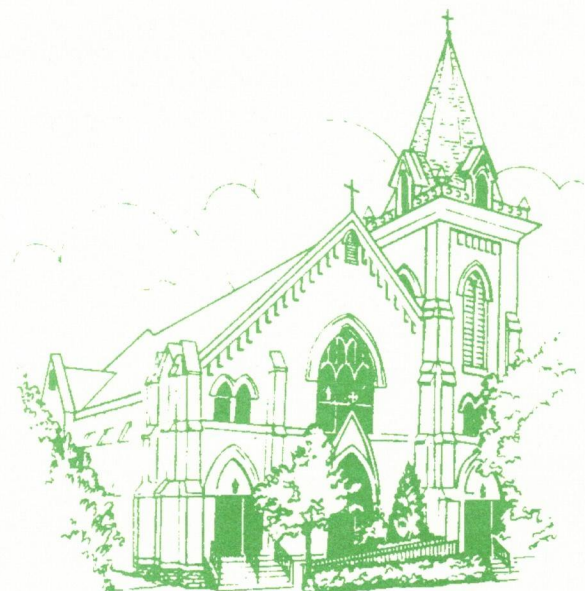

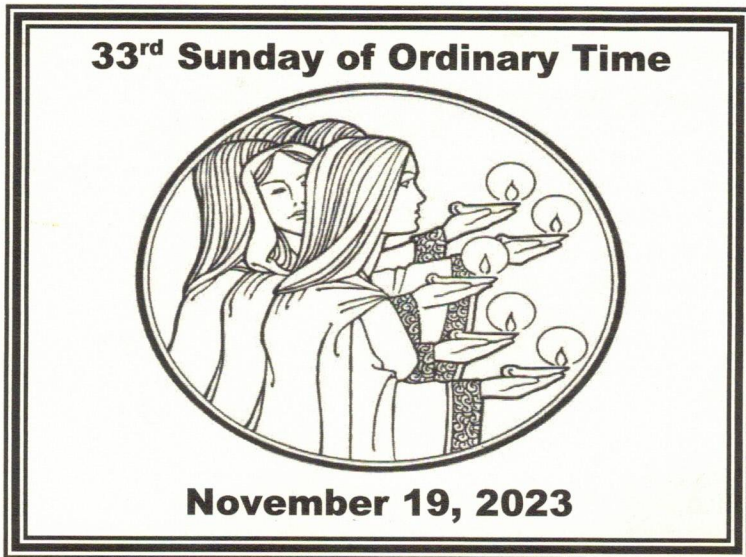

FEAST OF THE WEEK – November 21st

Feast of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a liturgical feast honoring the Virgin Mary by the Roman Catholic, Eastern Orthodox and some Anglo-Catholic Churches. The presentation of Mary in the temple by Joachim and Anne was in thanksgiving for a vow made by them to consecrate their gifted daughter to God. Joachim and Anne had grieved for many years about being barren and not having a child. They prayed and pleaded with God, even vowing to consecrate the child to God if their prayers would be answered. This event was not revealed in the Old or New Testaments, but in the Protoevangelium of James, a written document which is dated just prior to the year 200 AD. Observance of this event originated in the 6th century. At the age of three, Mary was taken to the temple and was said to have remained there, being taught by the temple priests until the age of twelve – many believe in preparation to be the Mother of God. By this time, Mary was an orphan and was betrothed to Joseph, who became her guardian. This Feast is the culmination of the cycle three Marian feasts (The Birth of Our Lady, the Holy Name of Mary, and the Presentation of Mary) that correspond to the cycle of three feasts in the life of Jesus (Christmas, the Holy Name of Jesus, and His Presentation at the Temple.) Mary’s presentation in the temple also draws parallels to that of the prophet Samuel, whose mother Hannah, like Anne, was thought also to have been barren, and who offered her child as a gift to God at Shiloh. The Feast of the Presentation of Mary, although it had been celebrated in the Eastern Church since the Middle Ages, was not included in the Roman Calendar until 1472 by Pope Sixtus IV.

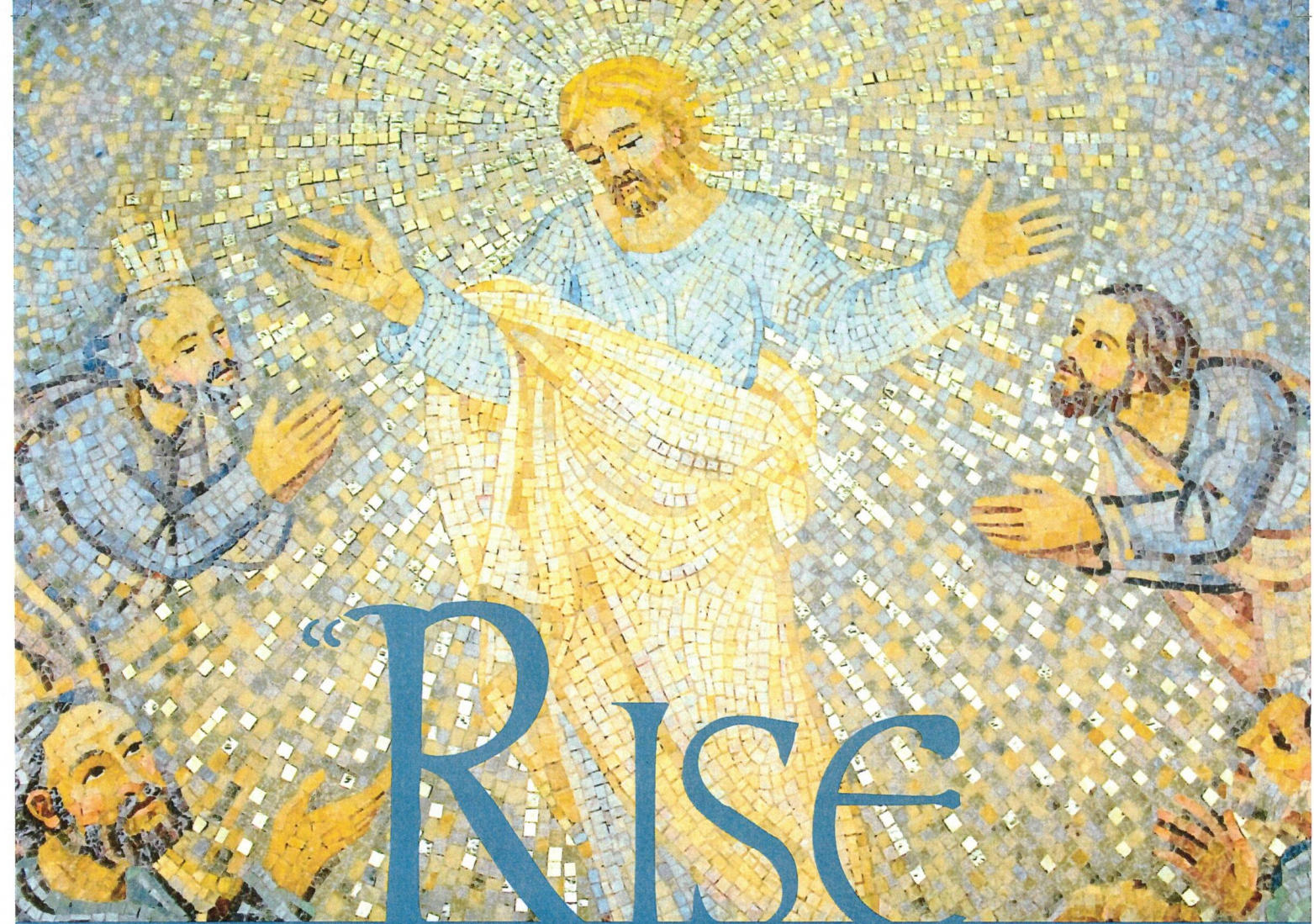

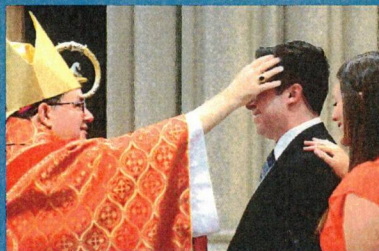
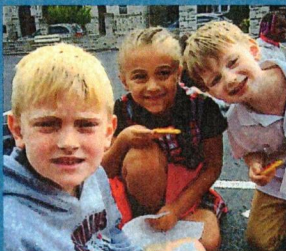

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

Please place a blank gift tag on the package with the number of the dove on the tag. If the item is small, please place it in a small box or gift bag with the dove and a blank tag attached to the outside.

Please bring the gifts to the church and place them under the tree. Then put a red dove on the tree. All gifts must be under the tree by Sunday, **December 10th**. The gifts will be distributed the following weekend.

Helpful Tips

- ✚ We suggest a limit of \$25.00 per gift.
- ✚ Please do not buy additional gifts since each child gets several. This could result in one child in the family getting six gifts and the rest get two ... oops this is not what is intended!
- ✚ Do not take the dove with you when shopping to prevent it being lost. It is important that they are returned with the gift.
- ✚ If possible, put a gift receipt in with the gifts, especially if it is shoes or clothing.
