



## SAINT OF THE WEEK - September 28th

St. Wenceslas was born in the year 907 AD in the town of Stochov near the present day city of Prague, Czechoslovakia during the "Dark" Middle ages. He was born into royalty, his father Vratislaus I being the Duke of Bohemia and his mother Drahomíra. At age 13, Wenceslas' father (a Christian) died and St. Ludmila, his paternal grandmother, took it upon herself to raise him properly as a Christian. The death of Vratislaus destabilized the family greatly, as Drahomíra, a pagen, rejected Wenceslas being a Christian. During this time, Ludmila fled in exile, but was not able to avoid being strangled to death in 921 by an agent of Drahomira. She tried to assert her influence on Wenceslas to dissuade him from his faith, but was not successful in doing so. In 924, Wenceslas assumed the throne ruling Bohemia. He promoted Christianity in the kingdom even though it being majority pagan. He found it necessary to exile his mother who continued to try to disrupt and usurp his authority. He was described as a great peacemaker and took a vow of virginity. He was a benevolent king to the poor and built many churches for them in which to worship. In 929, Wenceslas' younger brother Boleslaus, an heir to the throne, with the help of Drahomira, plotted to kill him and found the opportunity when Wenceslas invited him to celebrate the feast of Sts. Cosmas and Damien together. Upon their arrival, Wenceslas was slain at the church door by Boleslaus - dismembering and burning his body at the site. Wenceslas' last words were "Brother, may God forgive you." Due to Wenceslas' life of great virtue and the number of miracles attributed to him following his death, he was declared the Saint of Bohemia and a symbol of Czech pride. Since the year 2000, his feast, September 28th, has been observed as a pulic holiday in Czechoslovakia.. Patron of Bohemia, Czechoslovakia and Slovakia.




