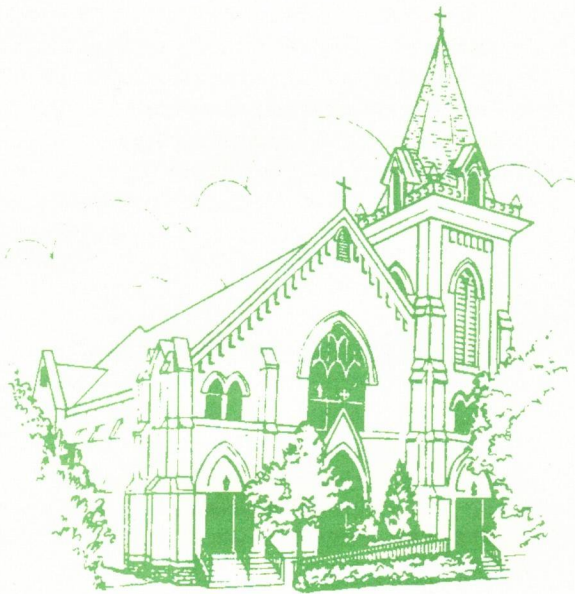

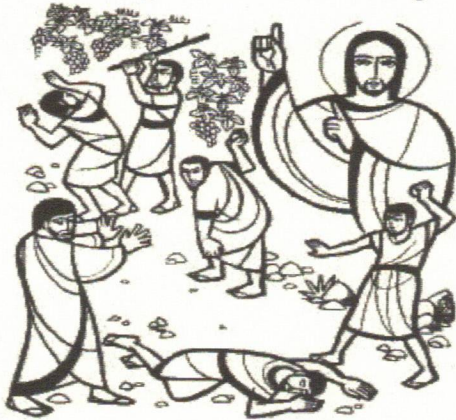

**SAINT OF THE WEEK – October 14th**

**Pope St. Callixtus I** – was the Bishop of Rome from 218 until his death in 222 AD. Little is known about his early life, except that he was a slave in Rome. His master put Callixtus in charge of collecting funds that were distributed for the care of widows and orphans. Callixtus fell to the misfortune of losing some of the collected funds and fled Rome in fear of retribution. He was captured on Portus and taken before his master who sent him to Sardinia to work the mines. He was near death there when Pope Victor I sent him to Antium to recuperate. He was ordained a deacon there and was named the superintendent of the cemetery on the Appian Way. Today, this cemetery is known as the Catacombs of St. Callixtus. The cemetery was to become the burial place of many popes and was of the first land holdings of the Catholic Church. Callixtus was elected pope in 218. From the start of his presbyterate, he began admitting converts from sects and schisms that had not done proper penance through promoting the absolution of all sins including adultery and murder. This so shocked the some in the Christian community in Rome that the first anti-pope, Hippolytus was elected as a rival pope. Callixtus was believed to have been martyred either by the Roman authorities or possibly even his rivals in the Christian faith. His body was found in a well by Asterius and buried in the cemetery at Calepodeus on the Aurelian Way. Asterius was arrested for this action and was killed by being thrown off a bridge into the Tiber River. Callixtus' remains were later moved in the 9<sup>th</sup> Century to Santa Maria in Trastevere. His martyrology appears in the 4<sup>th</sup> Century Depositio Martirum as October 14<sup>th</sup>. **Patron of cemetery workers.**
