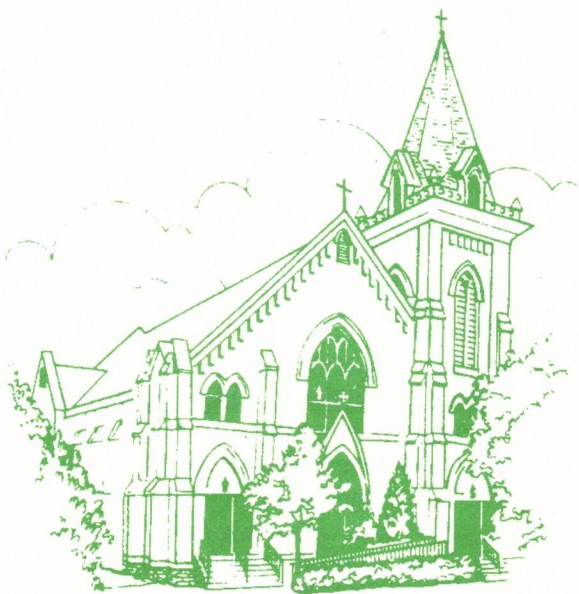

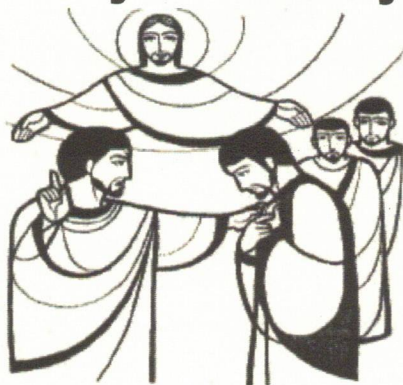

**SAINT OF THE WEEK – September 17<sup>th</sup>**

**St Robert Cardinal Bellarmine** – was born on October 4, 1542 in Montepulciano in southern Tuscany, Italy. He was the son of noble, yet impoverished parents Vincenzo Bellarmino and Cinzia Cervini. Cinzia was the sister of Pope Marcellus II. As a child, he read and wrote poems and hymns. In 1560, Robert entered the Jesuit novitiate in Rome and was there three years before he next went to a Jesuit house Mondovi to learn Greek. From there, he was sent to the University of Padua and then University of Leuvan, where he was ordained in 1569. He taught Thomistic philosophy while at Leuvan. In 1602, Robert was ordained the Archbishop of Capua where he helped to enforce a decree from the Council of Trent concerning the non-residence of bishops living outside their diocese. He was ordered by Pope Paul V in 1616 to summon Galileo Galilei to present the decree of the Congregation of the Index that first persuaded him not to continue studying and promoting the science of the earth's movement around the sun. Later, Galileo was embroiled in the great Inquisition trial in 1633 that resulted in him being convicted of heresy for his continued study of heliocentrism, and spent the remainder of his life under house arrest. Bellarmine, among others, defended Richard Hooker's philosophy of the dignity of men to be governed by self-determination under natural law rather than Martin Luther's and Thomas Hobbes' view of the system of monarchical absolutism. Bellarmine has being credited with inspiring John Locke, among others, that the Founding Fathers of America were reading and inspired by when formulating the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution. Bellarmine died as a Cardinal of the church in Rome on September 17, 1621. **Patron of canonists, canon lawyers, catechists and the catechumens.**
