FEAST OF THE WEEK – November 1st

The Solemnity of All Saints is the celebration in honor of all the Saints of the Church, whether they are known or unknown. This feast dates back to the 4th century, which originally commemorated only Christian martyrs on various dates near Easter and Pentecost. In the 9th century, in the British Isles, this Christian feast was moved to November 1st to coincide with, and possibly detract from, the pagan feast of the Druids known as Sanhaim, the occult and macabre Celtic festival of the dead. In the same century, Pope Gregory IV decreed the date of November 1st as a holy day of obligation in accent with all the bishops in the Roman Empire. In Catholic theology, this feast commemorates all those who have attained the beatific vision in Heaven. The celebration of All Saints Day and All Souls' Day stems from a belief that there is a powerful spiritual bond between those in heaven (the "Church triumphant"), and those still living on earth (the "Church militant"). In association with all saints, the Litany of Saints was established as formal prayer in the Catholic Church as an invocation and intercessory prayer to the Blessed Virgin Mary, the angels and saints upon who were significant founders of Christianity. The Litany of Saints is prominently sung on celebrations at the Easter Vigil, All Saints Day, and at liturgies on which Holy Orders is conferred. The official Litany of Saints is most recently found in the 1974 version of the Roman Gradual. In the Gradual, it is divided into five sections - the Supplicatio ad Deum (Prayer to God), the Invocatio Sanctorum (Invocation of Saints), the Invocatio ad Christum (Invocation to Christ), the Supplicatio pro Variis Necessitatibus (Prayer for Various Needs), and the Conclusio (Conclusion).




