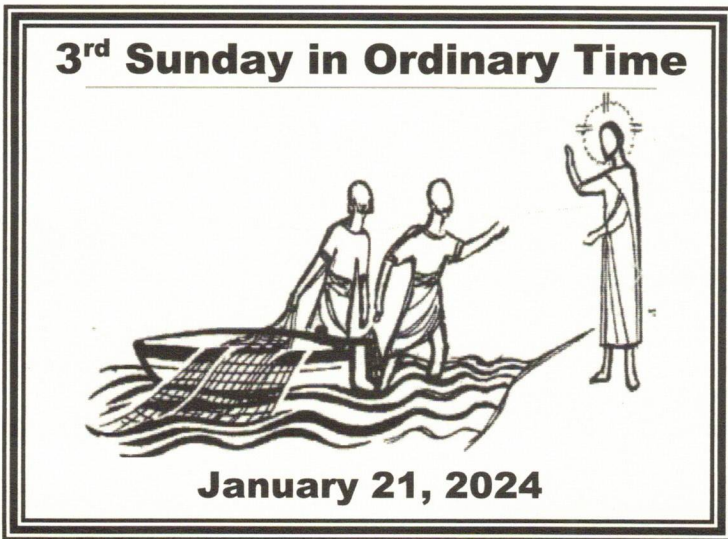

FEAST OF THE WEEK – January 25th

Conversion of St Paul is the feast celebrated by the Catholic Church to commemorate the event in the life of Saul of Tarsus that led him to cease persecuting early Christians and to become a follower of Jesus, known as Paul the Apostle. Before his conversion, Saul was a scholarly, learned Jew, described as a “Pharisee of Pharisees.” Saul was determined to destroy Christianity in its infancy. He was said to have been an active participant in the stoning of St. Stephen. Saul was en route to Damascus to continue to search for Christians to persecute. Accounts in the *Acts of the Apostles* describe that Saul was commissioned by the high priest in Jerusalem to arrest and bring back with him to Damascus any Christians for questioning and possible execution. When nearing Damascus, he was rendered defenseless; blinded and knocked from his horse. Jesus called out to him “Saul, Saul, Why do you persecute me?” Jesus revealed his identity and instructed him, “Now get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.” Saul, being blinded was taken to the house of Judas in Damascus by those traveling with him. Ananias was a disciple of Jesus and led the Christians in Damascus. He received divine revelation to go to Saul and lay hands on him. Ananias was reluctant to go, owing to Saul’s fierce reputation against Christians. He obeyed God’s command and prayed while laying hands on Saul. Saul immediately regained his sight after this and actively sought baptism. He took some time to reflect on his conversion and prayed for guidance. He then began teaching in the synagogues in Damascus. Paul would go on to evangelize gentiles in the Greek-speaking world and would be martyred in Rome. He experienced much suffering for his endeavors and is heralded as one of the most important apostles for his zeal for Christianity in his writings.

“Restored in Christ” Campaign

This weekend at the Masses, a second collection will be taken up for the exterior façade repair of the Cathedral Basilica named the “Restored in Christ” Campaign. After 100+ years of enduring the weather, freeze-thaw cycles have taken their toll on the sandstone capitals, gargoyles, and artistic scrollwork, cracking and breaking apart the façade. This is the 3rd phase of a 6-million dollar fundraising campaign for this project. Work will commence in the spring of 2024.

Into Life Series – St. Pius Church Jan/Feb

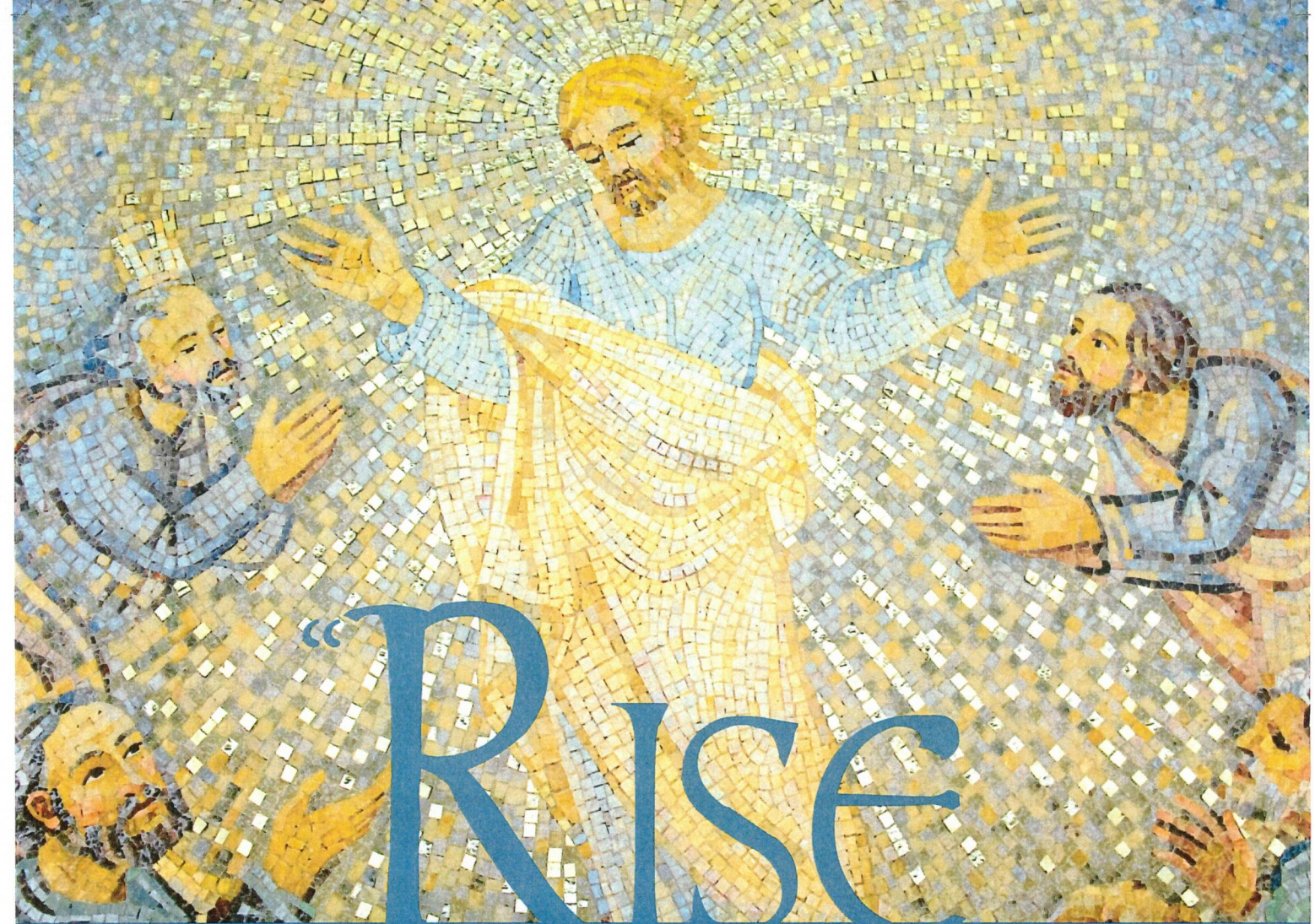
