SAINT OF THE WEEK – October 21st

St. Hilarion was believed to have been born to pagan parents in the year 291 AD in Thabatha south of Gaza in Syria. He was an anchorite who were those that chose to withdraw from secular life to devote themselves solely to God in intense prayer. What we know of Hilarion comes to us through the writings of St. Jerome in 390 AD while he was living in Jerusalem. As a youth, Hilarion studied rhetoric in Alexandria where he was exposed to Christianity and was converted. He was inspired by St. Antony, the renowned desert hermit, and at age 15, went to seek him out and lived at his hermitage for a short time. Antony was a highly sought after figure for physical and demonic (spiritual) cures. Antony's hermitage proved to be too hectic and distracting for Hilarion and he withdrew to the simplicity and hardship of the Gazan desert to live a nomadic life in solitude. Jerome wrote of the many temptations and demons Hilarion had to face such as hunger and sexual desires. Hilarion eventually constructed a hut near Deir al-Balah (near present day Gaza City). His cell was dug into the earth with a low ceiling that had a rather tomb-like in appearance. Jerome related how once Hilarion was beset by robbers who discovered that he did not fear death and had nothing worth stealing, quickly withdrew thinking he was near death due to his emaciated appearance. Hilarion lived in this hut for 22 years subsisting on lentils, dry bread with salt and water. When people learned where he was living, throngs came seeking spiritual and physical healing. Hilarion tried to escape his popularity by sojourning to Sicily, Dalmatia and finally Cyprus. Hilarion, by then, knew he was in decline; he was losing his eyesight and his skin was dry and itched incessantly. He died at an advanced age in Cyprus in the year 371 AD. St. Jerome wrote of the many miracles he had performed. A monastery grew up around his cell at Deir al-Balah. Herman Hesse used Hilarion's biography as the backdrop for one of the three lives of Joseph Knecht in his novel *"The Glass Bead Game."* **Venerated in the Eastern and Oriental Orthodox Churches and the Roman Catholic Church.**
