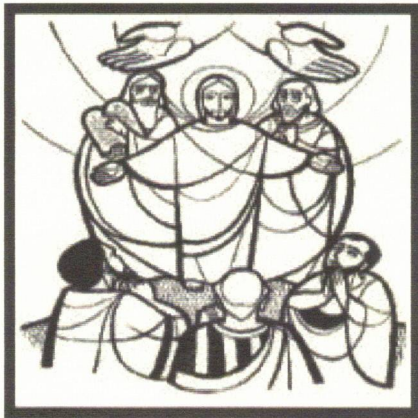

FEAST OF THE WEEK – August 15th

The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven is one of the major Marian Feasts celebrated in the Catholic Church and is designated as a Holy Day of Obligation. In his apostolic constitution, Munificentissimus Deus, Pope Pius XII, on November 1, 1950, exercised his papal infallibility to declare as official church dogma that Mary “having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.” This act finalized centuries of inquiry into the fate of Mary. Tradition held several possibilities: that either she died a normal and peaceful death; that she died a martyr; or that she did not die. The strongest evidence comes to us from chapter 12 of the Book of Revelation which describes a woman “clothed with the Sun” who escapes “the dragon” by fleeing into the wilderness to be nourished “for a time, and times, and half a time,” as a possibility of her immortality. Both Ephesus and Jerusalem had traditional, but conflicting claims to being the burial site for Mary and became focal points in the scholarly quest for more knowledge. In the late 4th Century, apocryphal sources posited that Mary died in the witness of the apostles. St. Thomas is reported to have requested the tomb in Jerusalem be opened and it was found to be empty. The apostles concluded the body had been taken up to heaven. Some of these sources in time were viewed as heretic and Jerusalem now has the strongest evidence as the tomb. This is supported by the fact that Mary’s veil is in the custody of the Basilica of Holy Mary Gethsemane in the Valley of Josaphat. Teaching of the bodily assumption of Mary began as early as the 5th Century by St. Gregory of Tours. There are two theories for the Assumption. The Roman Rite believes in the possibility of both posits that either she died naturally, was buried, and subsequently miraculously resurrected before being assumed into Heaven, or that she was assumed body and soul into Heaven without first dying. The Eastern Rite firmly believes only in the former position, that similar to Jesus, she first died before being assumed into Heaven. Both Rites agree that Mary surpassed both eternal death and final judgement and lives solely in the Age to Come in glory in Heaven.

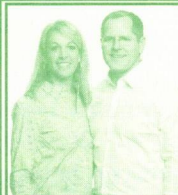
