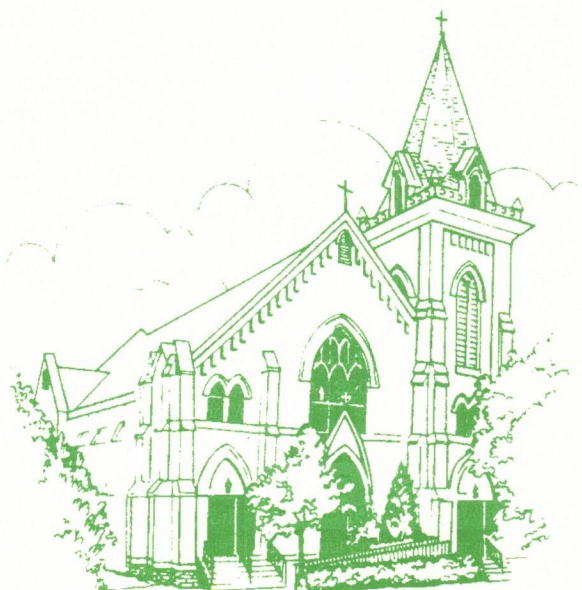

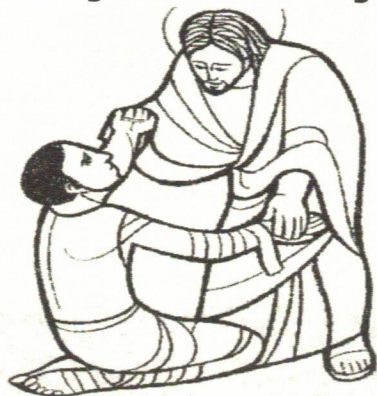

**FEAST OF THE WEEK – February 14th**

**Ash Wednesday** is the observance of the Roman Catholic Church that marks the beginning of the Lenten season (the subsequent 40 days that do not include Sundays). Lenten ashes are prepared from the burnt and pulverized palm fronds of the previous year's palm branches. Lent is a time in which we are encouraged to give our time, talents and treasure to a higher degree as reparation; a time to simply focus on our sinfulness and repent. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is more often sought out in this season as we approach Easter, the single greatest feast of the Church year. Although the association of ashes and sackcloth with penance and grieving is an ancient Hebrew practice described in the Book of Daniel, [9:3] the Christian ritual of marking the faithful with ashes did not come into widespread practice in the Roman Church until the 11<sup>th</sup> century. The first recorded use of ashes goes back to 6<sup>th</sup> century Gaul (modern day France), when public penance was practiced. Those who had been excommunicated or separated from God by serious sins would stand at the doors of the church dressed in sackcloth and be sprinkled with ashes as penitential psalms were sung. The doors were then shut and the penitents were not received back into the church until Maundy Thursday. Receiving ashes in the form of a cross on the forehead is a physical-sensory way of connecting the body with the spiritual life. Ash Wednesday has always been a popular observance in the Catholic Church and now more Protestant Christians are embracing the significance of this practice. It gives many Christians the opportunity to evangelize people that may ask about seeing ashes on their forehead or to just quietly display a Christian presence in our evermore unchurched Western culture. So, "Remember from dust you came, and to dust you shall return," by the action of "Repent, and believe in the Gospel."

### FISH FRY SEASON IS UPON US!

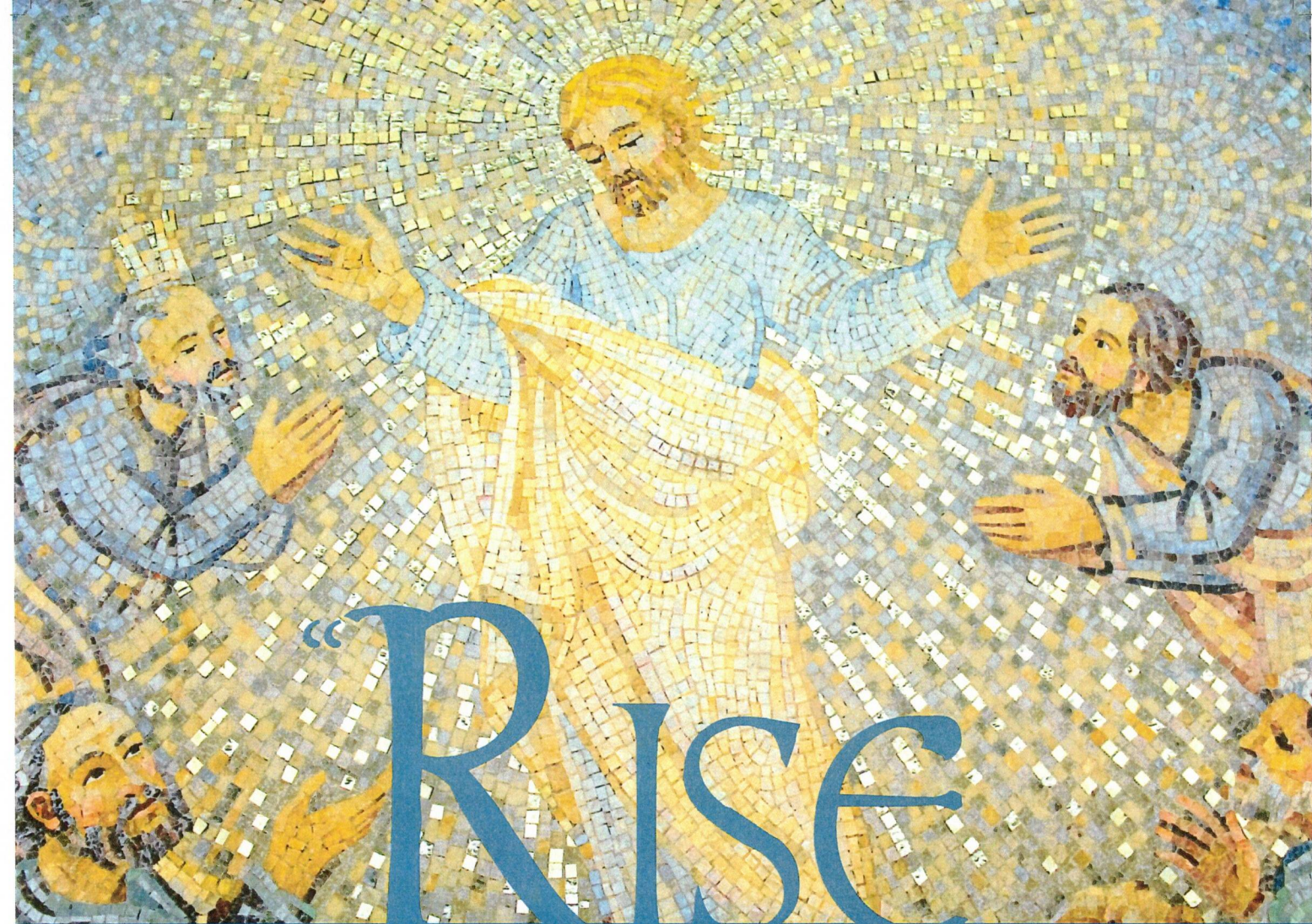
