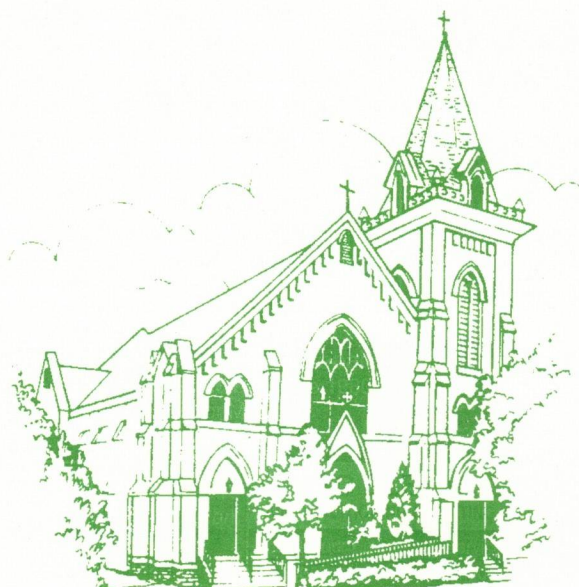

SAINT OF THE WEEK – February 18th

St. Simeon of Jerusalem was born sometime during the year between 15-14 BC. He was the son of Cleophas, who is believed to have been the brother of St. Joseph. Very little is known of his early life other than he was a prominent Jewish-Christian leader in Jerusalem. According to the Acts of the Apostles, Simeon was one of the disciples that was present in Jerusalem and received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Simeon in the year 66 AD, during civil war in Palestine, had been divinely warned and subsequently led the Christian community across the Jordan River into the desert to the small town of Pella. Around the year 70 AD, Roman legions led by Vespasian sacked and burned Jerusalem. When safe, they returned to Jerusalem to live among the ruins. The Church was flourishing at the time and many Jews were converting to Christianity. Simeon was then elected as the second Bishop of Jerusalem to succeed apostle James after his martyrdom, believed to be sometime soon after 70 AD. The apostles that were still living at the time (as many were still alive) came together and agreed that Simeon was worthy to follow James. The Roman emperor Trajan decreed that all descendants of David be destroyed. Simeon was not only a descent of David but also a devout Christian. He was arrested, tortured and condemned to death by Atticus the governor of Jerusalem. Although, at a very advanced age, thought to be about 120 years old, he endured his sufferings with such fortitude that many more were converted and even roused the admiration of Atticus himself. Eusebius, the great historian of the early church, cites that Simeon was crucified in or near Jerusalem in 107 AD.

HCHS Mulch & Pine Straw Sale

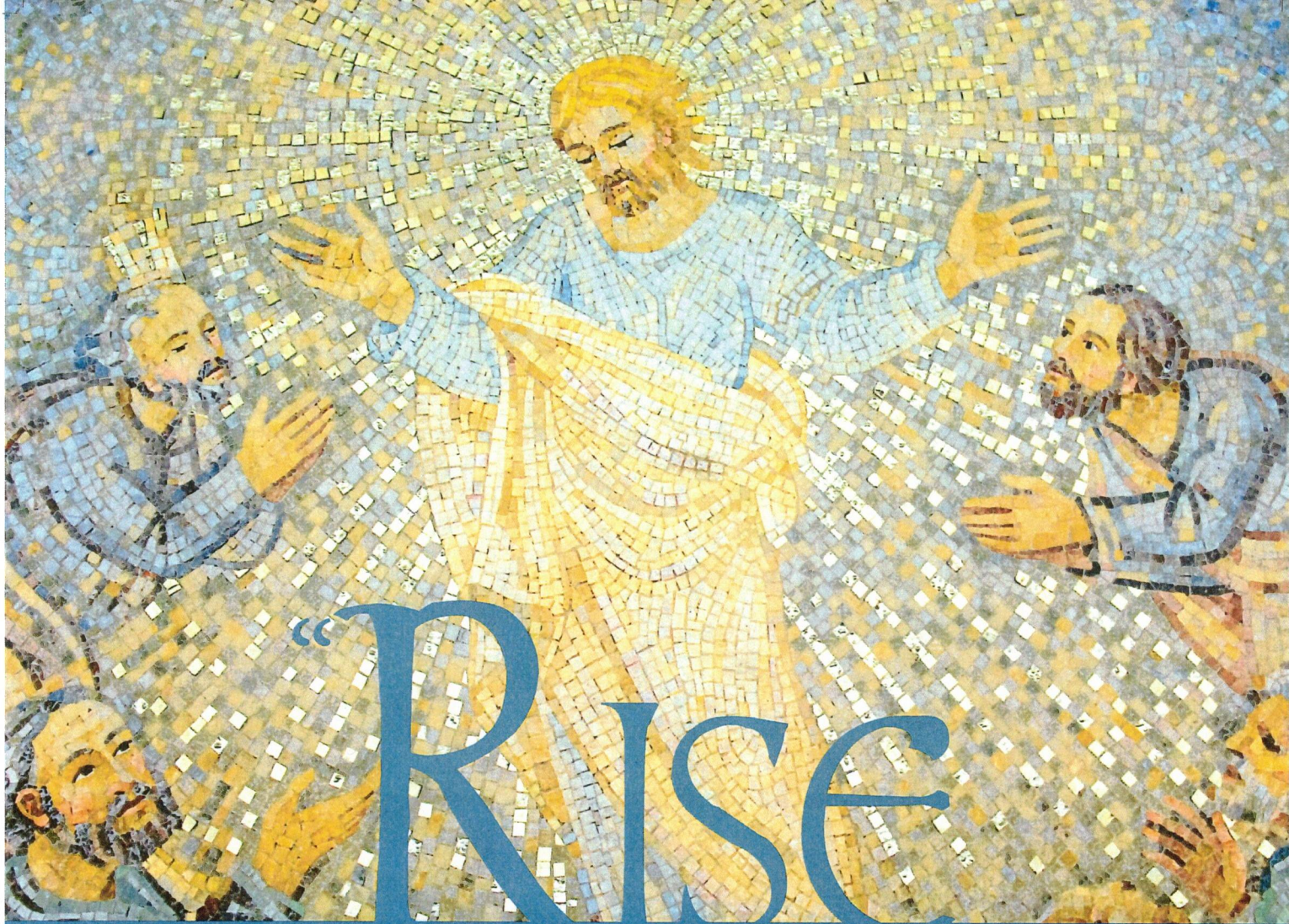
