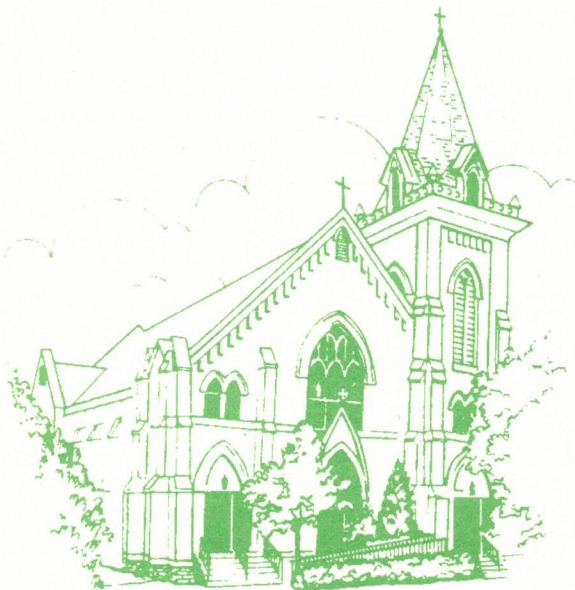

FEAST OF THE WEEK – November 16th

St. Gertrude the Great was born on the Feast of the Epiphany on January 6, 1256 in Eisleben, Thuringia (present day central Germany). At the age of four, she entered the Benedictine monastery school of St. Mary Helfta. There is some speculation that she entered at this tender young age as an oblate by either devout parents or more likely as an orphan. At the age of twenty-five, she began to experience a series of mystical visions that changed the course of her life to be more devout in prayer. She became one of the most esteemed woman's saints through her writings, such as, her *Spiritual Exercises* that are themes and rites of Catholic liturgy for occasions such as Baptism, conversion, commitment, discipleship, union with God, praise of God, and preparation for death, and her *Book of Special Grace*. Gertrude had a particular devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Through her visions, she wrote of resting her head near the wound in the Christ's side and hearing the beating of His heart. She asked the Apostle John if, on the night of the Last Supper, he had felt these pulsations, and why he had never spoken of the fact. John replied to her that this revelation had been reserved for subsequent ages when the world, having grown cold, would have need of it to rekindle His love. Gertrude also had a great devotion for praying for the dead for the redemptive repose of their souls. Gertrude showed "tender sympathy towards the souls in Purgatory" and urged prayers for them, invoking aid of the suffering souls in Purgatory by the prayer that is now attributed in her name. Gertrude died on November 21, 1302 at the monastery in Helfta. She was eventually canonized by Pope Innocent XI in 1677.
