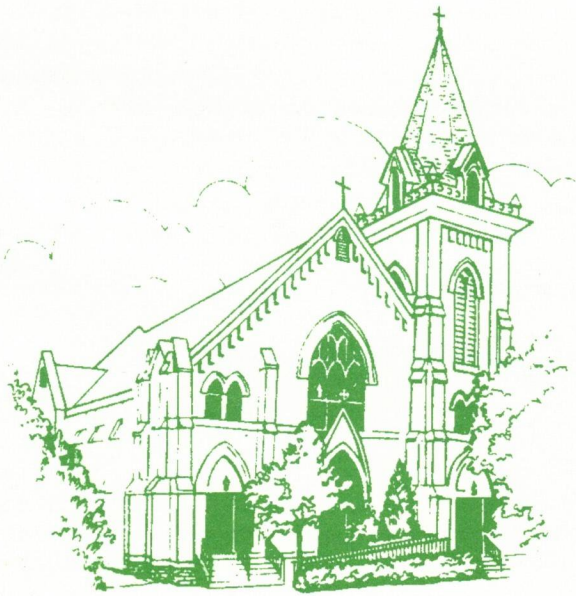

SAINT OF THE WEEK – October 1st

St Therese of Lisieux – was born Marie Françoise-Thérèse Martin on January 2, 1873 in Alencon, France to Louis and Zelig Martin. Therese was the youngest of nine children of which five daughters survived to adulthood. Four of the five Martin girls would eventually enter the Carmelite Monastery in Lisieux with the other becoming a Visitandine sister at Caen. Therese was a frail child, and described as a romantic idealist and dreamer, often prone to brooding when things did not go her way. Zelig was diagnosed with cancer and died when Therese was 4½ years old. The family moved to Lisieux shortly after the death of Zelig to be near her family for support. Her older sisters took charge of caring for Therese and was home-taught until she entered the Abbey School of Notre Dame du Pre at the age of eight. During this period, Therese began to fall sick often and was showing signs of neurotic attacks, scrupulosity and emotional frustration. This continued for years until 1886 after Midnight Mass at Christmas, in bed, she was miraculously touched by Jesus in a conversion-like manner that facilitated her cure. She had a totally different demeanor and felt free after that night. She felt immediately called to enter the Carmelite order at thirteen, but was declined due to her young age. She then became absorbed in reading *The Imitation of Christ* and in 1877 at age fifteen she made a pilgrimage with her father to Rome for the Jubilee of Pope Leo XIII. At an audience with the Pope, she got on her knees and pleaded with him to help her enter the Carmelite monastery. In 1888, Therese entered the Carmelite Monastery as a postulant. Her life as a Carmelite saw her mature in spirit and accomplish small things well - creating her “little way” of praying for the support of priests and missionaries. In the mid 1890s, her health deteriorated and she became frail as tuberculosis set in. She died on September 30, 1897. She was canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 17, 1925 as the youngest Doctor of the Church. **Patron of missionaries, HIV/AIDS & tuberculosis sufferers, florists, gardeners, orphans and homeless people.**

Mother of God Cemetery – Annual Visitation

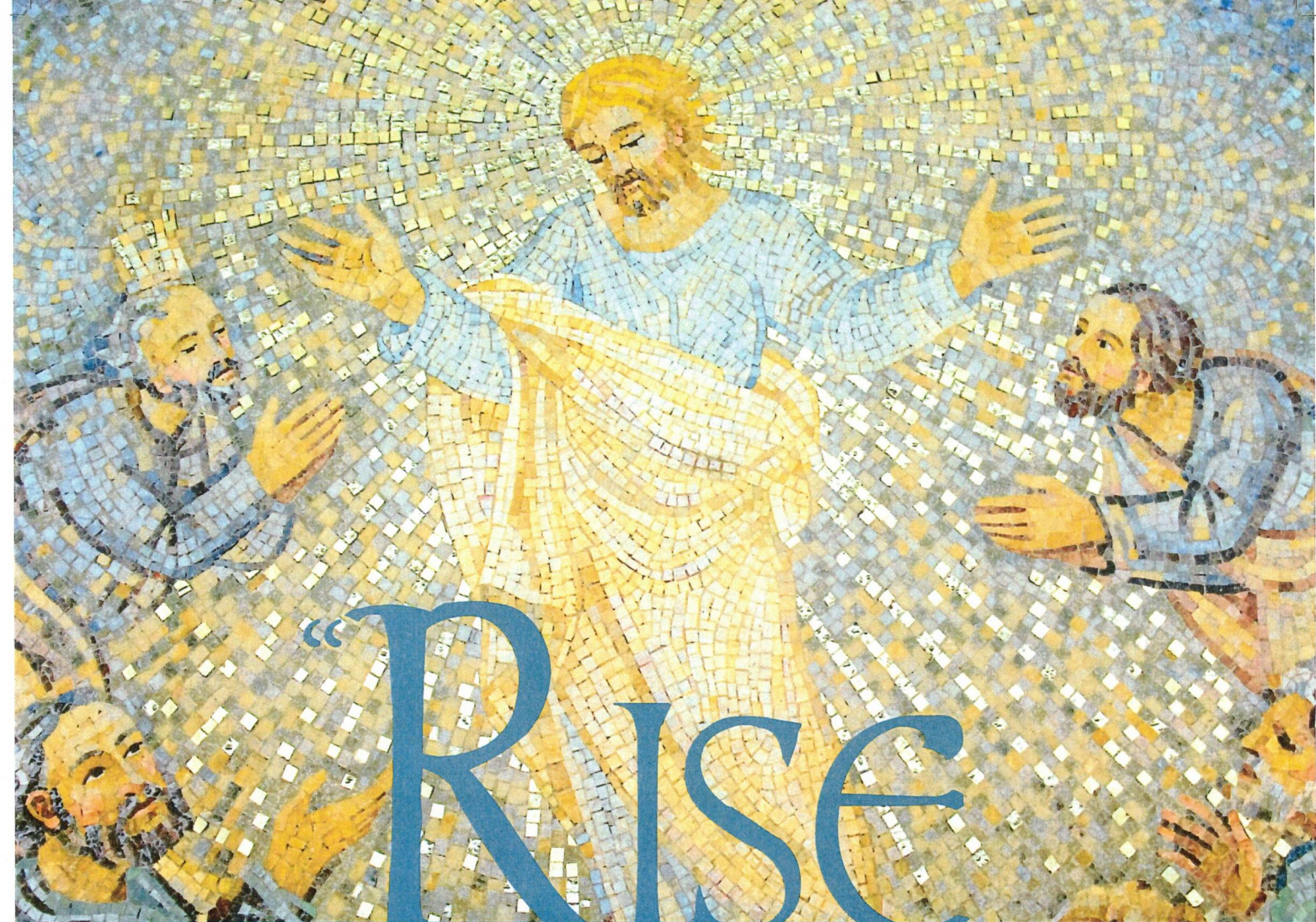
