# SAINT OF THE WEEK - February 8th

St. Josephine Bakhita was born as one of the Daju people on an unknown date in 1869 in the village of Olgossa, Darfur, now western Sudan, She was part of a loving family. Her father was the village chief and she had three brothers and three sisters. When she was eight years old, she was abducted by Arab traders and sold into slavery. Over the next twelve years, she was sold four times. The previous three owners had been cruel and abusive to her. The last master to purchase her was the Italian Vice-Consulate in Khartoum, Callisto Legnani. He was kind to her and, after two years, was called back to Italy. She was then given to a friend, Augusto Michieli. Khartoum had become a dangerous place for Europeans, so Augusto took Josephine and made the risky trip to the port of Suakin. In March of 1885, Josephine begged Augusto to take her with him back to his family. So they sailed to the port of Genoa, Italy, then on to Veneto, just west of Venice. Josephine became the nanny to his three children for three years. Augusto returned to North Africa with his wife and left Josephine and the children with the Canossian Sisters in Venice. Josephine was instructed in Catholicism while there. Michieli returned to Venice in November 1889 to take his children and Josephine back to Africa. Josephine refused to go with him. Michieli pushed back and sought the help of the Italian Attorney General. The court ruled that when Josephine was acquired by Michieli in Khartoum the British had already outlawed slavery and Josephine was declared free of all contracts, and was, in essence free. She was baptized in January 1890, entered the novitiate with the Canossian Sisters in December 1893, and took final vows on December 8, 1896. During WWII, the townspeople in Venice considered her a saint and felt safe by her presence. Josephine was described as having a gentle calming voice and ever-present smile. Although she never left Italy, "her mind was always on God, and her heart in Africa." She died on February 8, 1947 and was canonized in October 2000 by Pope John Paul II. Patron of Sudan and human-traffic survivors.

## Into Life Series - St, Pius Church Jan/Feb


