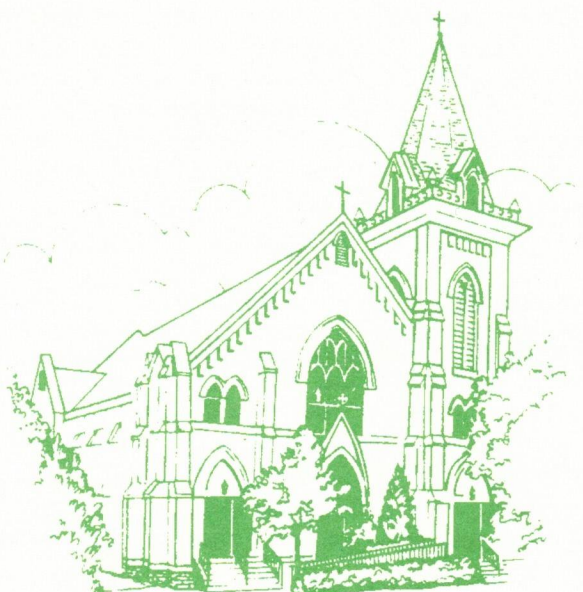

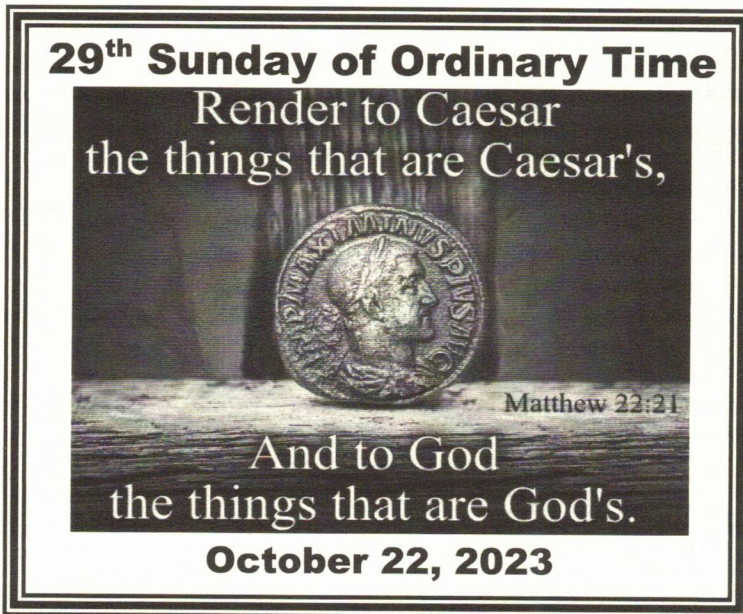

SAINT OF THE WEEK – October 26th

St Peter of Alcantara – was born sometime during the year 1499. Little is known of his early years. Shortly after his return from the university at Salamanca at the age of sixteen, he entered the Franciscan Order at the friary of the Observants in Extremadura. Six years later, he was sent to help found a new community of Franciscan Observants in Badajoz. He was ordained a priest while at Badajoz and was shortly thereafter transferred to the province of Castile to become the guardian at the friary of St Mary of the Angels. It was during this time that Peter began his itinerant preaching widely throughout Spain with great success. He preferred preaching to the poor using the Prophetic Books of the bible and what is known as the Sapiential Books, which is a genre of literature made up of storytelling and wisdom from the sages of time. He was known to "breathe the tenderest of human sympathy" into his narrative. He was renowned for his austerity and living in genuine poverty and fasting – eating once every three days stirred great respect for him among the poor. Peter in his later years had much difficulty sleeping and spent a great deal of time in nocturnal Eucharistic Adoration, which owes to him being the patron of night watchmen. Peter was elected to minister general in 1538 for the Province of St. Gabriel in Extremadura. His initiative of reforming the Observant practices of the day was met with robust opposition. Deflated by this, he resigned his position and fled to the mountains in Portugal to lead a hermitic life with also-sainted, John of Avila. Peter wrote his *Treatise on Prayer and Meditation* while there, that was widely acclaimed as a masterpiece. He spent much of his later years in prayer and contemplation and was known to be a great mystic. Legend has it that Peter died bent over on his knees and when offered water, he stated, "Even my Lord Jesus Christ thirsted on the Cross." **Patron of night watchmen, Eucharistic Adoration, Extremadura, Spain and Brazil.**
