

SAINT OF THE WEEK - February 15th

St. Claude la Colombière was born in 1641 in the city of Saint-Symphorien-d'Ozon, then in the ancient Province of Dauphiné (France). He was the third child of Bertrand la Colombière and of Margaret Coindat. The family soon moved to the nearby city of Vienne, where he began his education, before attending the Jesuit school in Lyon for his secondary studies. In 1658, at age seventeen Claude entered the Jesuit noviciate at Avigion. After ordination, he spent several years teaching grammar and literature there. After fifteen years as a proclaimed preacher of his order's Spiriual Exercises, in 1675 he was assigned as the spiritual director for the Visitation Sisters at Paray-le-Monial. This assignment seemed to be beneath a cleric of his experience - but it turned out to be anything but ordinary or mundane. There, he met St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Sr. Margaret Mary was at a low place in her spirituality and self esteem having had a number of personal revelations with Jesus that her community did not believe or support. Fr. Claude supported her and she confided openly about what Jesus was instructing her to do. He ardently convinced her community at the convent to listen and act on what Sr. Margaret Mary was requested to do through her revelations with Jesus. Fr. Claude himself became totally engrossed as a supporter of the Sacred Heart of Jesus movement. The last several years of his life, he moved to England as the spiritual aid to the Duchess of York and future King James II. He was arrested there and imprisoned as being part of the Popish Plot. He was expelled from England with the help from King Louis XIV and died at Paray-le-Monial on February 15, 1682 due to severe hemorrhage. Patron for the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.


