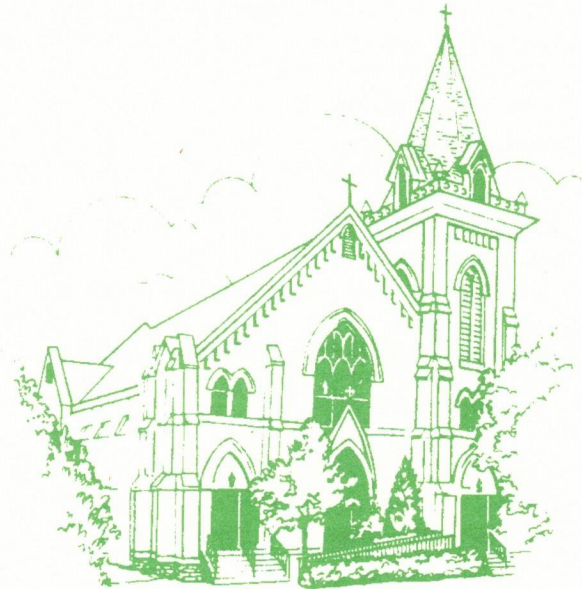

SAINTS OF THE WEEK – October 19th

Sts. Jean de Brebeuf & Isaac Joques – were among the first of numerous French missionaries to the Huron, Alcoquin, Mohawk and Iroquois tribes that faced martyrdom in North America. In the early sixteen hundreds, the French Jesuits finally had established a stable mission in New France under their superior Jean de Brebeuf, centered in Quebec of present-day Canada. The Huron and Alcoquin tribes were generally a more peaceful people and many readily accepted the message of Christianity. As contact was eventually made with the Iroquois and Mohawks, they were more fierce and hostile to the “black robes” and blamed them for the smallpox outbreak that had killed and sickened many of the natives in the preceding years. In 1642, Fr. Isaac Joques was captured by the Iroquois and was led from village to village over thirteen months, being slowly beaten and tortured in reparation for perceived transgressions. He was able to escape with the help of Dutch traders and traveled back to France to recover. Pope Urban VIII granted him special permission to celebrate Mass in an extraordinary manner, due to his mutilated hands. Fr. Isaac still desired to serve in the missions and returned to New France in 1646. Shortly after his arrival, he and a companion Jean de Lalande were captured by a Mohawk war party. Fr. Isaac was tomahawked and beheaded immediately and de Lalande, the following day. Fr. de Brebeuf continued his service to the Huron people. Being very well educated, he notably created a written Huron alphabet and composed a dictionary and catechisms in the language of his faithful. In 1649, the Iroquois attacked the mission. Fr. Jean could have escaped, but elected to remain with the Huron, as he knew many would be tortured as violently as him. The North American Jesuits were canonized in 1930 by Pope Pius XI.

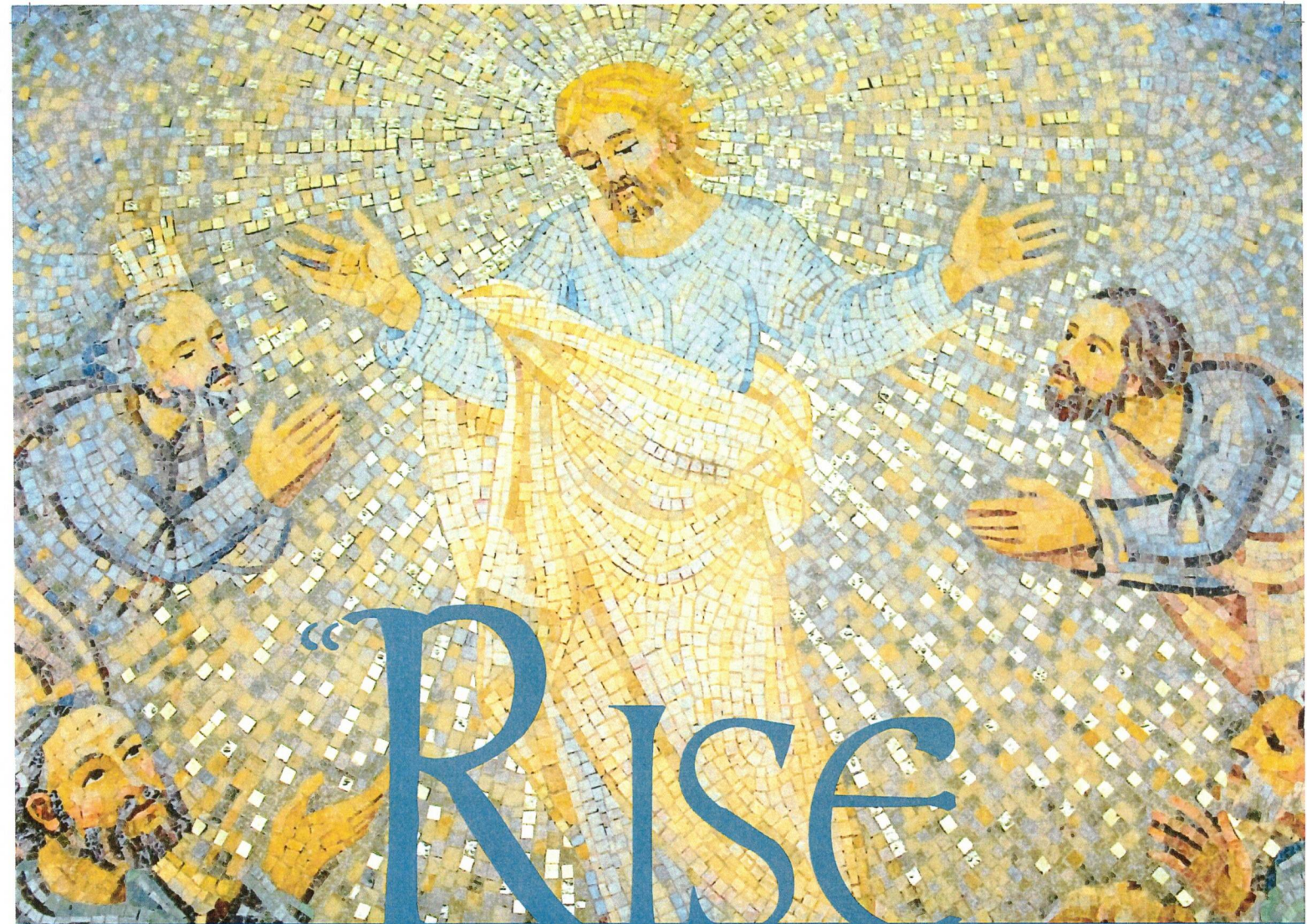

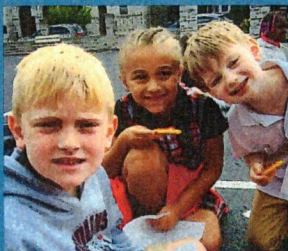

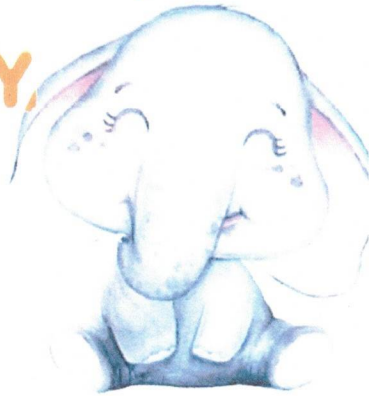
