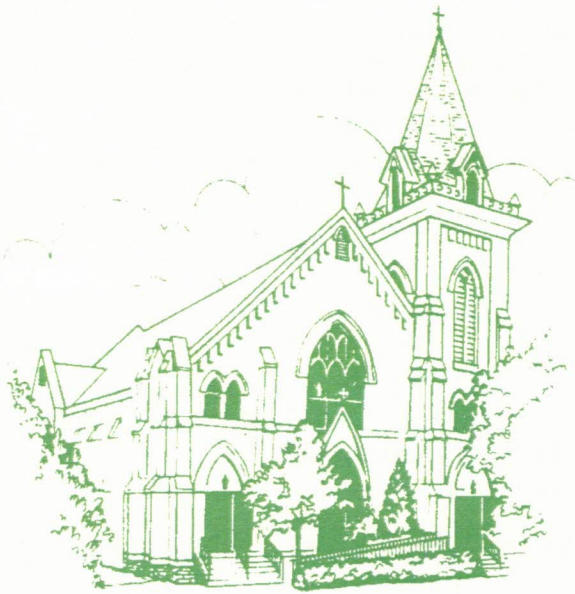

**SAINT OF THE WEEK – February 18th**

**Bl. Fra Angelico** was born and baptized Guido de Pietro sometime in the year 1395 near Fiesole in the Tuscan Region of Italy. Nothing is known of his parents, family or early life until 1417, at the age of twenty-two he joined a lay religious confraternity at the Carmelite church in Fiesole. His occupation was listed as a painter. In 1423 he entered the Dominican Order and took the name Fra Giovanni (Fra meaning friar) where he was known to be an illustrator in the Dominican Order of great talent. Fra Angelico painted during a time when the world of art was experiencing major change. He straddled the Gothic style of the late middle-ages with the infancy of the newly emerging Renaissance style. Much of what he painted was in the fresco style, which constituted painting onto freshly layed plaster which was a dramatic but unforgiving medium, where one had to work without haste. Fra. Angelico painted a large number of sanctuaries, altar screens and pieces, chapels, and walls in convents and monasteries in Florence, Cortona, Fiesole and the Vatican and around Rome. He also has works on display in several of the most prestigious museums in Europe. Fra Angelico died at the Dominican convent in Rome on February 18, 1455, at the time working for Pope Nicholas IV. In addition to his great works of art, he led the life of an ordinary friar, aiding the poor and was always found in good humor living by his motto: *"He who does Christ's work must stay with Christ always."* Pope John Paul II found great reason to beatify Fra Angelico on October 3, 1982 for his talent that was borne out of great simplicity and humility.

This year we will retain the tradition of being directly marked with the sign of the cross with ashes on the forehead and the individual recitation of the prayer, *"Repent and believe in the Gospel"* over each penitent.

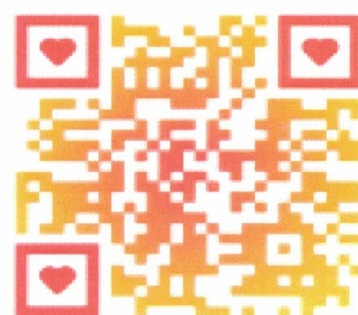

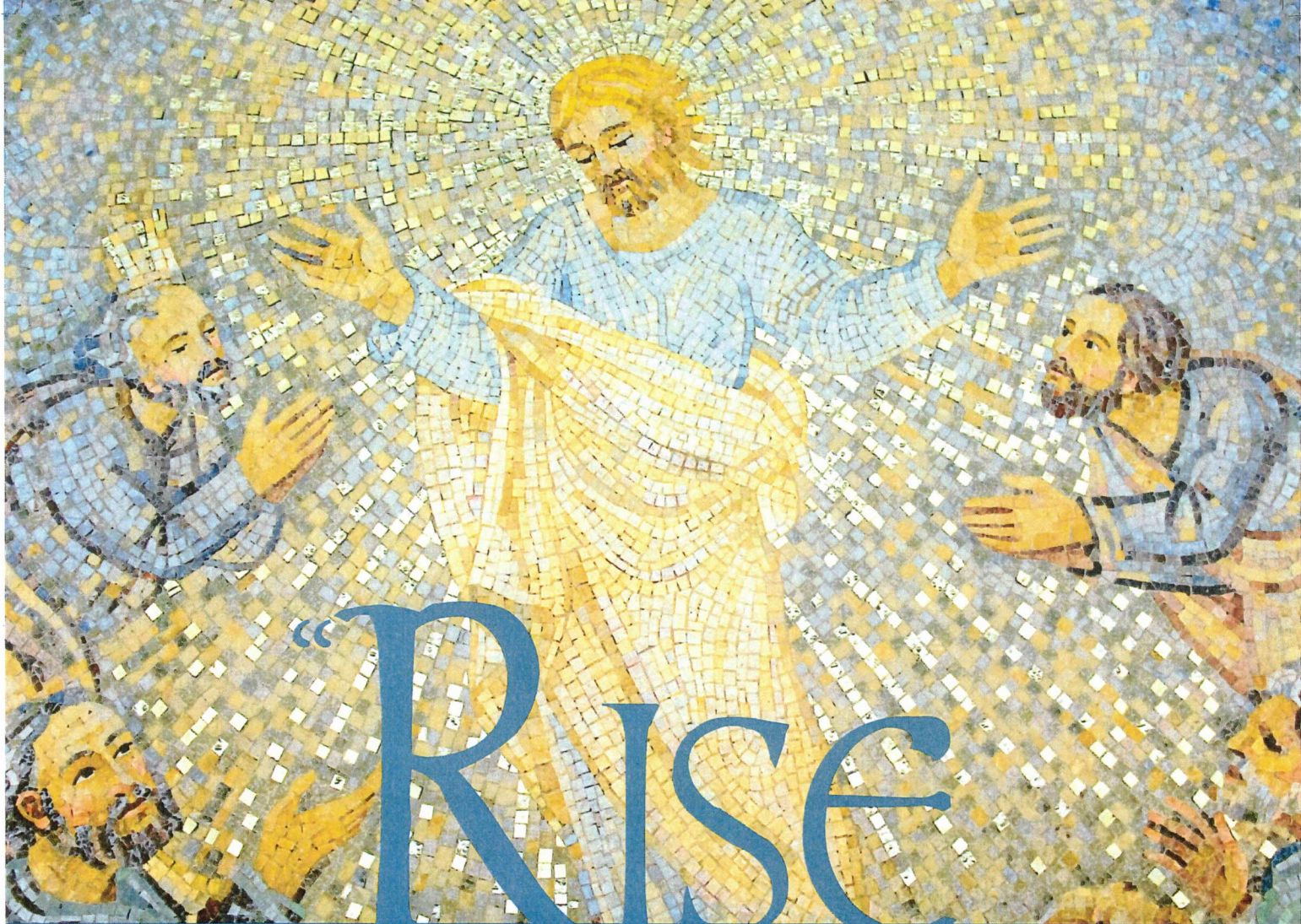

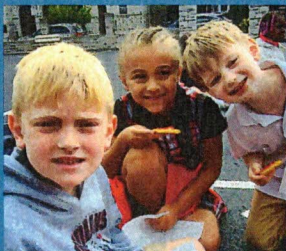
