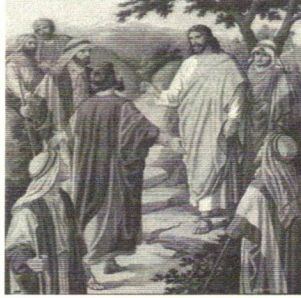

SAINT OF THE WEEK – January 20th

St. Fabian was born of Roman nobility. His father was named Fabius, but nothing further is known of his upbringing. He became the 20th pope to succeed Peter in 236 AD in the most unusual of circumstances. Fabian came to Rome from the countryside and was present during the papal election, but he was largely unknown. Historian Eusebius wrote that "he [Fabian] was in the mind of no one." After thirteen days of the election process where no clear candidate was gaining favor, in the midst of all the electors, a dove landed on Fabian's head. The congregation took notice of this and it eerily reminded them of how the Holy Spirit had descended on Jesus in the form of a dove at his baptism. All took notice and Fabian was at once proclaimed pope by popular acclamation. There was a lull in persecutions during his papacy and Fabian was influential at working with the imperial government at gaining the return of the remains of many martyrs. He is credited with forming several minor orders in the church, that of porter, lector, exorcist, and acolyte. His peaceful papacy came to an end when Decius came to power and again began persecuting Christians. Fabian was arrested early in this campaign. Fabian is believed to have died in 250 AD, languishing in prison, suffering from hunger and neglect.
